Richard Przychodzin A former area resident, Richard Przychodzin, 37, of Fulton, died Monday, Aug. 6, 1979, at the Mercy Hospital in Clinton, Iowa, after a long illness.

Mr. Przychodzin was the principal of Fulton High School in Fulton since 1975. He was the former principal of the Union-Whitten, Iowa, schools from 1971 to 1973 and the Lynnvill-Sully, Iowa, schools in 1974. He received his bachelor of education degree at Southern Illinois University-Carbondale and his master's degree in administration at the University of North Iowa in Cedar Rapids, Iowa.

He was a member of the Lions Club in Fulton; the Phi Delta Kappa Fraternity, a professional education fraternity, and the Illinois Principals association at Fulton. Mr. Przychodzin was a member of the Immaculate Conception Catholic Church in Fulton.

He was born Feb. 16, 1942, in Murphysboro, to Joseph and Eileen Brewer Przychodin. He was married Oct. 17, 1965, in Williaville, to Valeria Downen.

Survivors include his wife; daughters, Stephanie and Danielle, at home; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Przychodzin of Cedar Falls, Iowa; one sister, Judi Przychodzin of Westminster, Colo.; three brothers, Benny of Washougal, Wash., Phil of Massena, Iowa and Joe Jr. of Maquoketa, Iowa; and maternal grandmother, Gladis Brewer of Murphysboro.
